





Subject: Waiver of Graduate Student Tuition Remission Charges on State of Georgia
Department of Transportation Sponsored Agreements

The Graduate Student Tuition Remission Program (GSTRP) procedures include provisions to request a waiver of GSTRP charges to specific sponsored projects. Such requests are to be considered for approval by the Vice Provost for Research and Graduate Studies.

Your request for a continuation of the waiver of all GSTRP charges against sponsored projects funded by the State of Georgia Department of Transportation has been considered by Dr. Charles L. Liotta, Vice Provost for Research and Graduate Studies, and approved on April 3, 2000. This action continues the approval of the waiver of charges on these projects initially authorized by Dr. Jean-Lou Chameau (then Vice Provost for Research and Graduate Studies) on January 21, 1997. This action recognizes the Georgia Department of Transportation awards in the same manner as other projects funded with State of Georgia resources.

The provisions of this waiver should be reviewed and renewed when significant changes are made to the GSTRP program or in five years (May 4, 2005) to confirm the continuing need for this waiver.

Copies of this waiver should be included with supporting documents for all new awards with the State of Georgia Department of Transportation. Questions concerning any of the provisions of this memorandum should be forwarded to the Director, Grants and Contracts Accounting Office.
